



CONDITIONS OF USE FOR USERS OF LEYS LEISURE SPORTS CENTRE

Leys Leisure Sports Centre (at The Leys School, referred to throughout as “the School”), Trumpington Road Cambridge, CB1 7AD.

To ensure the safety of all users, the School requires all users to observe the following Conditions of Use of the Leys Leisure School’s Sports Centre.

If you do not understand any part of these Conditions of Use, please speak to one of our staff members for assistance.

General Use

Users must conduct themselves and their activities in an appropriate manner.

Food is only allowed in the Sports Centre foyer.

All instructional signage must be complied with.

Use of the Sports Centre by any user is subject to standards of good behaviour and manners. Use of offensive, abusive or discriminatory language or violent, offensive or intimidating behaviour or conduct will result in consent to use the Sports Centre being withdrawn.

User’s pets are not permitted inside any of the sports facilities of the Sports Centre.

Smoking and/or vaping is prohibited in all areas of the School.

Photography and Social Media

Users are prohibited from taking photographs or videos in any of the School’s facilities, including the swimming pool. In exceptional circumstances users can make a request via the Sports Facilities Manager.

The School reserves the right to ask users to stop taking photographs or videos and delete them, as appropriate.

The School operates a safe environment and asks that all users/guests of the Sports Centre use social media in an appropriate manner, having regard to other users’ privacy.

Any use of social media identifying staff members or other users or revealing personal information, without obtaining prior consent, will be taken seriously and use of the Sports Centre may be withdrawn.

Parking

The car park is located near the Sports Centre on the School site.

External users are only entitled to use the School’s car park whilst using the facilities.

Car parking is not always guaranteed and is offered on a first come first served basis.

Cars are parked at the owners own risk. The School does not accept liability for any loss or damage to vehicles or personal belongings.

Parking is not permitted near the swimming pool that is only used as a drop-off location.

Health and Safety

Users are responsible for their own health and safety and must wear appropriate clothing and non-marking shoes to participate in any activity on the School site.

Users must not obstruct designated fire escape routes, doorways, corridors and staircases.

The fire assembly point is located on the fire poster in each building.

External Users’ Information Only

External users must not interact with any of the School’s pupils.

All external users must complete a pre-exercise questionnaire before using the Sports Centre and should consult their doctor before starting any exercise or exercise programme. External users are responsible for their own medical clearance in relation to using the Sports Centre.

External users must not walk across the School site to get to and from the swimming pool and car park, they should walk around.

Hard Courts/Astros/Squash Courts

Appropriate sporting attire must be worn at all times. Appropriate non marking shoes and squash goggles would be worn on the squash courts at all times. Only astro shoes may be worn for participation in any activity on the astro.

Use of the astro is for educational institutions and purposes only.

Use of Tannoy/PA systems is strictly forbidden.

Hire times must be strictly adhered to and the School is not responsible for and cannot guarantee availability to use the hard courts, astro and squash courts the same day if users miss their hire time.

Swimming Pool

Users are required to adhere to all instructional signage and verbal instructions from staff to ensure the safety of all users.

No running on the poolside. No diving or jumping in the swimming pool, unless permission is granted by a qualified swimming instructor.

Anyone who is feeling unwell should avoid swimming.

Gyms

Only users over the age of 18 can use the weights area, or, if under the instruction and guidance of a member of staff who is a registered personal trainer.

Any person providing instruction/coaching to a user within the School’s facilities must be registered to provide instruction/coaching and be appropriately qualified and insured, copies of current certificates must be provided to the Sports Facilities Manager before any sessions begin. All instruction will be subject to an appropriate fee.

Equipment

Attendees of the weights or Cardiovascular (CV) areas are not permitted to bring in their own gym equipment.

Property that is brought into the Sports Centre is done so entirely at the person’s own risk.

Equipment belonging to the Sports Centre that is damaged through misuse or negligence will be replaced at the user’s cost. Further use of the Sports Centre will be withdrawn until appropriate costs have been paid.
